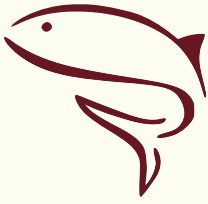

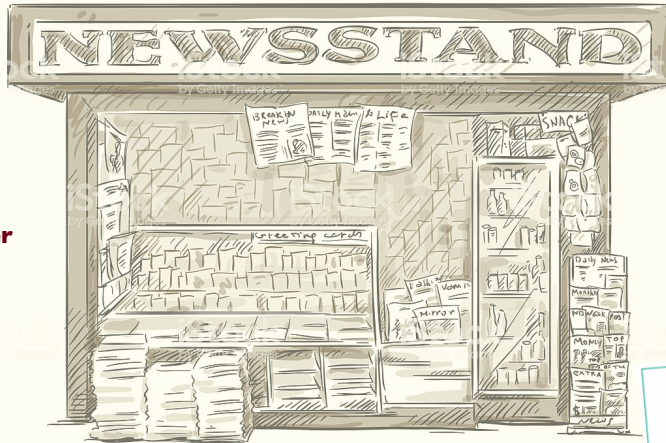

Message from Mr Kelly

This is not the start to the new year that any of us wanted to happen - the Isle of Man went into Lockdown 2.0 during our first week back to school after the Christmas break. Although it was not the situation we had hoped to find ourselves in, Laxey School was in a very strong position to respond to the circumstances having reviewed our provision from the original lockdown, drawn up our plans for future lockdowns and prepared thoroughly. This enabled us to hit the ground running as soon as the lockdown started, and we began our remote learning response immediately. This involved a comprehensive learning package on the website for each year group, independent challenges, daily recorded video messages from the teachers as well as a daily online live-lesson offer. I have been really impressed with the level of engagement from our pupils and the level of support from parents and families has been phenomenal. We do not take this for granted at Laxey School and the staff team and I are keen to ensure that our remote-learning packages are helpful to children and households. Many of you have already been in touch, and I'd encourage you to continue to raise questions, queries and comments with us as we progress through lockdown so that we can respond and evolve our work to better reflect your needs. I'd like to close this section of my newsletter by putting on record my thanks to the whole school community: we have all pulled together so well at this time of crisis and I'm proud to be associated with such a fantastic group of children, families, teachers and wider staff. Wellbeing
