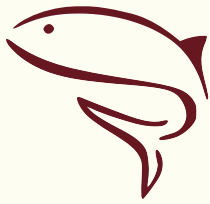

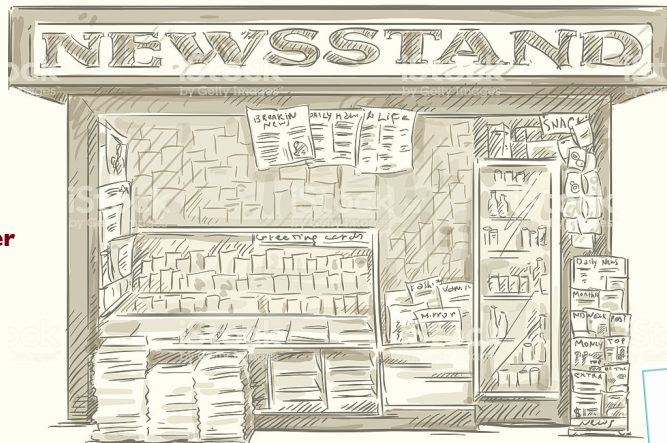

Message from Mr Kelly

Here we go again, another lockdown in the Isle of Man. This one feels different to the circuit breaker in January. We are seeing increased transmission, which unfortunately is affecting children and young people in a way we haven't previously seen in the Island. Late last night it was announced that all schools would close to all children and all young people with immediate effect. I'm obviously acutely aware that this will have significant knock-on effects for our families with essential key workers and my team and I will do everything we can within the restrictions placed up on us to continue to offer as much support and help as possible. I am very pleased to say that we will be continuing our remote learning package throughout the new closures, although the live lessons have previously been hosted on the internet infrastructure in schools and now will have to run from the bandwidth in teacher's homes, so please bear with us. Over the coming days and weeks my team and I will be proactive in reaching out, and earlier today you should have received a text message from me to check that you're all OK.

Turning to more positive news, it was fantastic to see so many of our children and families joining in with our World Book Day celebrations earlier this week. Thank you to all of the children who took the time to email me with a photograph of themselves with a favourite book, and I hope you enjoyed the assemblies during the day too. I do have a book token for every child which I will hold onto for now and will hand out once we get everyone back in school. Bridge Bookshop have confirmed they will honour the tokens after the lockdown period ends.
