

Guided Reading Task Card

Do you know what a full stop is?

Copy a sentence that has a full stop at the end.

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Look through the book that you are reading.

Find 3 words that you find tricky to read, and write them down.

Sound them out to a grown up.

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Talk to a grown up about what is happening in the book.

Draw a picture to show what has happened so far.

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Look at the pictures in your book.

What clues do they give you about the book?

Draw your favourite picture.

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Interview time! Alrighty then, time for some tough questions. Write down a bunch of questions that you would like to ask one of the characters in your book. Then, answer those questions as if you were the character!

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Choose a page in your book. Look at the picture.
What clues does it give you about the story?
Write them down.

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What are the names of the characters in your book?
Try drawing a picture of them and write their name beside them.

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What do you think will happen next in the book that you are reading?
Write it down or draw a picture and then you can see if you are right!

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Can you remember any facts that you have found out from the book you are reading?

Write down something that you have found out.

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Make a storyboard of the events in the story that you are reading.

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Who are the characters in your story?

Write their names down and then write a sentence about each character.

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Choose 2 characters from the book that you are reading.

Are they similar or different? Why?

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Have you enjoyed the book you are reading?
Why / Why not?
