The Maths lessons for the next 2 weeks are focusing on TIME.

The stretchy link covers the skills that we cover during Year 1 when we do time and focuses on:

- *Naming and ordering the months of the year
- *Sequencing events in chronological order
- *Measuring time in minutes and seconds
- *Reading and writing the time to o'clock (Part 1)
- *Reading and writing the time to o'clock (Part 2)
- *Reading and writing the time to o'clock and half past (Part 1)
- *Reading and writing the time to o'clock and half past (Part 2)
- Reading and writing the time to o'clock and half past in words
- Explore adding on hours and half hours
- Using language of direction, position and movement

The stretchier link covers the skills that we cover during Year 2 when we do Time and focuses on:

- *Knowing the number of hours in one day
- *Knowing there are 60 minutes in one hour
- *Identifying quarter past on an analogue clock
- *Identifying quarter to on an analogue clock
- *Identifying quarter past and quarter to on an analogue clock
- *Reading the time on the clock to the nearest 5 minutes (Part 1)
- *Reading the time on the clock to the nearest 5 minutes (Part 2)
- *Sequencing daily events
- *Calculating duration of time in minutes
- *Calculating duration of time in hours and minutes
