

Choose a Challenge

During a 'Choose a Challenge' slot you can select any of the following tasks that are listed below.

You may decide to spend more time on certain tasks than others so feel free to carry a task over to the next day if needed.

Choose a Challenge tasks can include:

- Design your own theme park with at least 3 original ideas for rides.
- Design a new school uniform. Think about opinions of both boys and girls and varying age ranges.
- Write down 5 interview questions for a character from your favourite book. What answers do you think the character would give
- Write a script for a documentary about an animal of your choice. Find out facts about your chosen animal and record your documentary.
- You have won £1,000,000. How would you spend your money? See if you can spend all of the money or as close to £1,000,000 as you can. See attached sheet.
- Research about a 'Great Thinker' of your choice. Make a poster including key information about your chosen person.
- Design a new classroom. Your classroom should have space for 34 children and include an area for focus groups and a quiet area for brain breaks.
- Invent a new product and design an advert to go with it. Your product should be helpful to people in their homes and your advert needs to be eye catching and persuasive.
- Choose 2-3 animals and combine their features to create a new species that has been discovered. Draw a diagram to show the animal's features and include a brief description about its habits (habitat, eating habits, strengths and weaknesses, etc).
