

Staff Car Park

A reminder for everyone and an important message for parents & families new to our school concerns car parking. An electronic barrier is due to be installed shortly to help us better control vehicular access to the car park, so please begin getting into the habit of not driving down Quarry Road for drop offs and pick ups. Our temporary yellow safety barriers are in the process of being replaced by substantive fitted barriers which will also improve the safety of our pupils on site.
