

Ahoy Adults - This is a great opportunity to talk with your child about **why** and **how** we weigh things, hygiene and where ingredients come from.

Encourage observations from your child e.g. how is the fruit changing, notice **colour, smell, texture and taste.**

Imagination - Have fun, what sort of things can you spy together from your pirate ship whilst drinking your grog?

Language used - **weigh, measure, add, mix, mash, stir, blend, liquid, solid, grog, texture, number.**

Captains Orders - All good pirates must clear the decks, a clean ship is a happy ship, so don't forget the washing up!

What describing words can your child come up with e.g. **slimy, sloppy, runny, gloopy.**

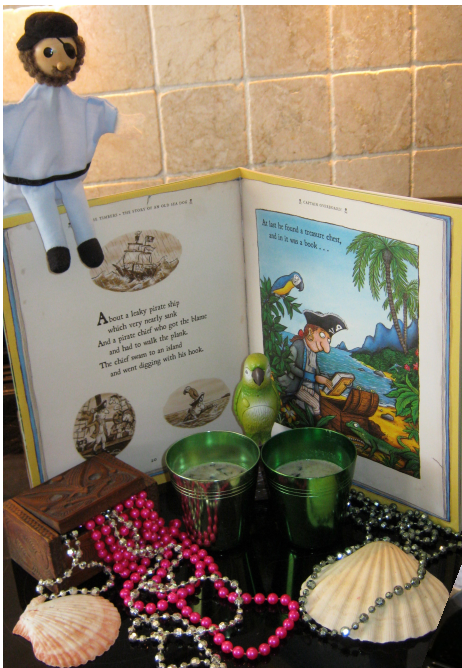
Does your child like it - Is it sweet or sour?

Captain Bluebeard's Pirate Grog

Make your own fruit smoothie grog.
(Adult supervision required!).

Makes approx 2 small smoothies, 1 for you and 1 to share with your crew!

Ingredients.

80g soft fruit -e.g. blueberries, banana, strawberries, raspberries, mango, kiwi, etc. (Don't panic, it can be a mix of which soft fruit you have available/which ones your child likes. Just one or two will do, its up to you. Don't forget Pirates are out to sea for long voyages and supplies may be running low me hearties!).

150ml milk or milk alternative

1 teaspoon of honey

1 teaspoon vanilla extract. (optional)

Potato masher

Colander

Weighing scales

Method

First wash those pirate hands.

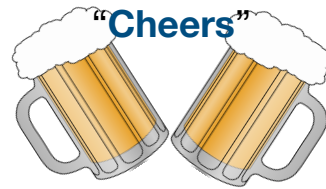
Weigh fruit and place in colander, rinse using cold water, drain.

Add fruit to mixing bowl and use those muscles to get mashing.

Once thoroughly mashed add the milk or milk alternative and blend together. (If you want more of a challenge and are not afraid of pirate mess mash fruit and milk together at the same time, Arrrrrrrrrr!). Make sure you get all the lumps out and its a smooth consistency.

Add honey and vanilla extract (optional).

Pour into your pirate tankard (cup) and enjoy a pirate party with your crew. Cheers me dears!



Adults you may want to use a blender to remove any remaining lumps once your little pirate has finished mashing.
