Here are a few more ideas you can do to help your learning at home....

- *Play musical sounds/numbers/tricky words
 on sticky notes or pieces of papers place
 these around the room. If the focus is
 numbers play the music and when it
 stops call out a number and your child has
 to run to it. Repeat with other numbers.
- *Try out our pirate maths games find the missing numbers, count the animals and Captain Redbeards number hunt.
- *Try out Captain Redbeards sounds and tricky words games.
- *Bake pirate biscuits or cakes. (These resources can be found on the school website)
