




Laxey Learners at Home this term (Further ideas to augment home-learning)

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Extension activities....

- * Listen to some stories written by children for the 500 word competition on the BBC. Talk to your mums and dads about each story.
- * What happened? What did you like about it?
- * Draw a picture of a character or setting from the story.
- * Try writing your own story.
- * Practise phonics, spelling and writing character descriptions based on the story 'George and the Dragon' through the Oak National website and daily video lessons.
- * Practise reading and spelling key words for Key stage 1
- * Try writing a diary of the things you've been doing at home. Draw pictures or stick in photos and examples of your learning.
- *Practise measuring Find things in your house that are taller than you and shorter than you.
- * Learn about the Manx flag. Try making your own.
- * Learn how to say 'good morning', 'good afternoon' and 'thank you' in the Manx language.
- * Practise drawing the animals from the farmyard in the book 'What the Ladybird heard' by Julia Donaldson (see the weblink)
